The kind of sin that is going to require patching things up with someone else? The kind of sin you don't have words to say to Jesus? The hymnal has the poem to pray. Here are some of the words, "Out of the depths I cry to you; O Lord now hear me calling. Incline your ear to my distress in spite of my rebelling. Do not regard my sinful deeds. Send me the grace my spirit needs; without it I am nothing." Hymn #515 "Out of the Depths I Cry to You." When you need a prayer after sin, this one is great. By the way, Scriptures encourage us not to sin! How do people live without hymnals!




