Welcome to Music Worship:

A divine season of worship – in remembrance of All Saints, in thanksgiving for God's free gifts, and in celebration of Advent in the birth of our Lord! We sing of our Lord's divinity and humanity in congregational hymns, in choir anthems, and in offertory solos throughout the Christmas season, all in praise of God's love for us.

One year ago my wife Phyllis and I were attracted to join this White Bluff congregation due to the warm welcome from members and our pastor, your enthusiasm for congregational singing, and the role of sacred music in weekly worship. Our first week here was through a bit of arm-twisting from our realtor, Jane Beare, who can be quite persuasive. I think Pastor Barry would call it "outreach."

By way of our musical background, Phyllis and I married in 1970 and directed a junior high and a senior high choir while I taught Bible at a denominational school. I have directed church choirs, large festival choirs, and a university performing choir. Phyllis has always accompanied me through these years. Our best six years in university were spent in directing 24 singers, four band members and four crew members, traveling through the Midwest from Texas to Minnesota from Alabama to Massachusetts during university spring breaks, performing in denominational congregations, staying with members in their homes. Not much sleep, but great joy.

Music worship is truly a collective effort by all our wonderful musicians. Suzanne Woodrum is our mainstay – over 35 years at White Bluff playing organ and accompanying soloists and the choir, opening the sanctuary and choir room, among other tasks. Rev. Cindy Layton, a recent addition to the choir, serves as assistant director, soloist, and sings with sisters, Linda and Nancy. Jane Beare plays solos and duets on our grand pianos, as does Phyllis, who also shares with Suzanne in accompanying the choir. We are blessed to have such musical talent who devote hours each week to prepare for worship.

Choir members practice each Wednesday from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Each voice is vital, and each member is committed to be prepared for each Sunday and for special days like Christmas. Our librarian Martha Adams keeps our music sorted and ready for practices and performances. Our sound crew does a great job, as they work with each component of worship, both for the sanctuary and those watching online.

On December 11th we will present our Christmas Cantata – "Were You There on That Christmas Night?" Please join us in celebration. See you there!


Portable Hand Ramp for Choir and Handbells

We will let the congregation know when the lift is ordered.






